



YOU WILL NEED

2 x 150g balls of Sullivans Elicia yarn

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- US size 15 knitting needles
- Wool needle for sewing in ends
- Large button (optional)
- 1" square of interfacing or heavy weight coordinating fabric (optional)

MEASUREMENTS

Approximate size 35" x 39"

DIFFICULTY ● ● ●

TENSION

Tension is not important for this project.

NOTE 1

Elicia yarn will stretch a little once is knitted and hung on shoulders.

NOTE 2

When joining the second ball of yarn, overlap a few holes of the end of the first ball with the beg of the second ball. This improves the look and provides extra strength.

WRAP

Using US size 15 needles, cast on 2 stitches. Knit 4 rows garter stitch
5th row: Increase in first stitch, increase in second stitch 4 stitches
6th row: Increase in first stitch, knit on last stitch, increase in last stitch
 Repeat 6th row until the first ball is used and approximately 3 yards of yarn remains from the second ball. Cast off but do not cut remaining yarn.

FINISHING

Use the tail of yarn after casting off to create a button loop. Secure by threading back into the cast off edge a few times. Sew in cast on end of yarn. Attach button to correspond with button loop. To help secure button, sew square of interfacing or heavy weight fabric on the back of the wrap, under the button. If you prefer, omit the button loop and button and secure your wrap with a brooch or kilt pin.
